Sustainability

Parking space:

18 parking spaces have been provided including 2 for disable people.

Instead of living the Stores in the underground level, they are in different levels planted to be easily accessible in each floor.

Entrance:

The centrally planted Entrance at the north and south side ease the access and have been located approximately in the ax of existing landscape.

Safety:

Refer to the rules for children with autism disabilities the areas must stay as simple as possible, therefore we have avoided any special forms of complicated objects in, And outside of the building.

Roof garden:

The roof absorbs the most sunshine energy during the day, And it is safe to play all day long since it is limited and it is under control. This space is divided the outside world with glass which also means that you have the view, Light and beauty inside. The music room is also here which means the sounds would not disturb the other departments and no need for expensive acoustic walls.
